Activate your access now. Take this page to your computer and follow these steps:

1. Go to <http://www.bodyworkmovementtherapies.com/claim/activate>


2. **If you have already registered:** Log in by entering your username and password.


*** In case you are unsuccessful in activating your access, please check on the following:

If you are able to see view full text access, there is no need to “claim/activate” your subscription as it has already been claimed/activated.

Should you encounter this error message: **“You do not have access to the content that you requested. Please review your options for gaining access at the bottom of the page.”** You will have to go to the claim page to activate your subscription.



2. Should you receive the error message: **“Please correct the following and try again. Could not activate token”**, it is possible you may have activated your claim code before with your email address, you may try the **forgot password** link to retrieve your login details.
